Plan A

Plan B

Full student attendance can be maintained with the following numbers of the school's own SSAs and/or familiar agency TAs present:

Class	Minimum number of SSAs / TAs
Yates	2, including one who can manage a student's particular medical needs

Rowsell	One, who can manage a student's particular medical needs

We can employ further agency staff if possible.

We might need to amend the curriculum as required. For example, offsite trips might not go ahead.

Plan C

Possible closure of named classes.

Students in Key Stages 4 and 5 will be given priority to attend school as they are working towards obtaining qualifications.

We would aim to provide remote learning for students who are not able to attend school. We would need to review this on an ongoing basis and it would largely depend on the staff available to provide this.

Plan D

Partial school closure.

We would provide onsite / school-based learning for students according to their RAG (red, amber, green) ratings.

RAG rating	School-based learning offer
Red	Full-time offer
Amber	As many days as possible, depending on student and staff numbers
Green	Some days as available, depending on student and staff numbers

Plan E

Full school closure.

We would aim to provide as much remote learning as we can.
